



ROUNDS 1-4: SCENARIOS

A

YOU ARE IN A COFFEE SHOP

Student 1: you are a worker. Ask the customers what they want and take their money.

Student 2: you are a customer. Buy a drink and a snack.

Student 3: you are a barista. Make the drinks and give them to the customers.

(Student 4: you are a customer. Buy a drink and a snack.)

B

YOU ARE AT THE STATION

Student 1: you are a tourist. You want to go to Oxford.

Student 2: you are a worker. Sell the right tickets to the customers.

Student 3: you are a ticket collector. Check that the customer has the right ticket for this train.

(Student 4: you are a tourist. You want a ticket for the next train to Manchester. Your train is leaving the station in 4 minutes)

C

YOU ARE IN A SUPERMARKET

Student 1: you are a tourist. You want to buy food for a picnic. You can't find the tomatoes.

Student 2: you are a worker. Tell the customers where the tomatoes and jam are.

Student 3: you are a cashier. Take the customers' money for the tomatoes and jam.

(Student 4: you are a tourist going to a picnic. You can't find the jam.)

D

YOU ARE AT A CLOTHES SHOP

Student 1: you are going to a party tonight. You need new clothes, the right colour and size.

Student 2: you are a worker. Help the customer to find clothes they like.

Student 3: you are a cashier. Make sure the customers pay for their clothes.

(Student 4: you are also going to a party and need some clothes.)



ROUND 3: PROBLEMS

A

IN A COFFEE SHOP

Read the other card, then read this card.

Problem 1: There is no milk, butter or sugar in the coffee shop today.

Problem 2: The barista is new in the job, doesn't know how to use the hot water machine, and all the drinks are late.

B

AT THE STATION

Read the other card, then read this card.

Problem 1: There are no trains to Oxford, only buses.

Problem 2: One of the customers buys the wrong ticket: it's for a train which goes at 23:48 tonight and arrives at 02:10 in the morning. They can't use this ticket before tonight.

C

IN A SUPERMARKET

Read the other card, then read this card.

Problem 1: There are no fresh tomatoes in this supermarket today: only tinned tomatoes.

Problem 2: One customer doesn't have cash. The card machine isn't working.

D

AT A CLOTHES SHOP

Read the other card, then read this card.

Problem 1: Some of the clothes aren't available in the colour the customer likes.

Problem 2: One customer tries to take clothes out of the store without paying.
